Six Yacht Clubs along the Sound hosted these races. We had an average of 10. 7 boats on each starting line, and a first place was won by 6 different skippers. Rich Foye managed a 1st and 2nd on the last day which earned him the prized half model trophy for the season. A breathless fog cancelled the Memorial Day Opener.
