Ensign Fleet 34 had a fun and active summer. The Season Championship Series consisted of a June, Early, and Late Mini Series. Thirteen out of fifteen scheduled races were held. Six Yacht Clubs along the Sound hosted these races. We had an average of 10.7 boats on each starting line, and a first place was won by 6 different skippers. Rich Foye managed a 1st and 2nd on the last day which earned him the prized half model trophy for the season. A breathless fog cancelled the Memorial Day Opener. In June the Fleet sponsored the Regional II Championship in which 15 boats participated. In July, 6 boats went to Newport for the VOLVO Regatta. No one made it to the Nationals. Through out the summer fleet members participated in special regattas, of which the Ram Island Invitational and Thames Governors Cup counted in the Series.

Early season practice starts instead of tune-up races proved to be a successful fleet experiment. The weekly newsletters were continued. The newsletter, mailed to 32 Fleet members and 18 Fleet Associates, is the "fleet glue".

The always fascinating season finale, the race around Fishers Island, was won by George Bates

who finished just ahead of Wes Maxwell and John Macina. It was his seventh win in the eighteen years he has raced for the Bill Jones Trophy.
