1991 Season

The summer of 1991 was a grand season for Fleet 34 in that 21 boats from this fleet of 32 participated in at least one race, while 10 boats made 4 or more of the 15 completed races. Only two races had to be canceled due to a lack of cooperation from Mother Nature. The fleet's races were hosted by five yacht clubs; Masons Island, Groton Long Point, Ram Island, Wadawanuck and Thames, the home of Fleet 57.

Racing started with the Memorial Day Invitational at the Wadawanuch Yacht Club. The first race was won by ROMANCE, sailed by Jerry and Trudy Daly. The five race Early Series was won by Ben Carpenter sailing SARI, while the 6 race Late Series was won by LA CHIC, skippered by John Macina. In addition, four boats from our fleet attended the Ensign Nationals in Noroton, CT, along with Hurricane Bob. Our own Bob Jones in FLYING HIGH, had the best performance amongst the Fleet 34 representatives at this event.

The Round Fishers Island Race was held on September 21 and we were blessed with beautiful weather. Spinnakers were required for approximately a third of the course. The race finished in a foul flooding ebb tide in Fishers Island Sound with the wind dying. John Macina, LA CHIC, finished first while the last boat finished one-and-one-half hours later.

Fleet 34's social schedule included three picnics and two dinner parties. At the Annual Meeting dinner party in November, the various champions were awarded their trophies. Nancy Bates, was awarded the Al Smith Sportsman Trophy for her long term service as secretary/treasurer and general coordinator of Fleet 34. Nancy Gibson was awarded the Bill Leuze Memorial Trophy for her performance.
