1995 Season

The 1995 ENSIGN racing season for Fleet 34 consisted of 13 races in Fishers Island Sound and Long Island Sound. David Motherway served as Commodore, Robin Durrschmidt as Vice Commodore and Gene Fiese as Secretary/Treasurer. The races were hosted by seven local yacht clubs.


The Early Series averaged 11.2 Ensigns/race and was won by Bob Jones in FLYING HIGH (92.4 points) followed by Ben Carpenter in SARI (91.3) and John Macina in La CHIC (90.4).

The Late Series averaged 14.2 Ensigns/race and was won by Bob Jones in FLYING HIGH (90.8) followed by Team (George) Bates in BONANZA (89.6) and The Horrigan Boys and Mary Ann in AIRBORNE (87.5).

Overall, the Fleet averaged 13 Ensigns/race (11.3 in '94) with 20 different Ensigns participating in the races throughout the '95 season. The Season Championship was won by Bob Jones in FLYING HIGH (92.8) to complete his sweep of the hardware. This is only the third time in the 28 year history of Fleet 34 (thank you Gerald Daly) that the same skipper has won both the Early and Late Series Championship. Second place for the season went to George Bates in BONANZA (89.6) and third place to Ben Carpenter in SARI (88.9). The Ayers Trophy for the best performance in June went to Ben Carpenter in SARI while the Bill Leuze Trophy for most improved performance throughout the year went to Robin Durrschmidt in Mr. Frisky. The participation was great and the racing close as indicated by the scoring results.

Other award or regatta winners from Fleet 34 this season were John Macina in La CHIC in the Robert Jones Trophy race on Memorial Day. Ben Carpenter in SARI won the Wadawanuck Invitational while the Horton One Design was won by Bob Jones in FLYING HIGH. Denny Smith in ABORN AGAIN won the Governor's Regatta at Thames Yacht Club and Team Woodruff in NIGHTWIND won the Commodore's Trophy Regatta also at Thames. Paul Smyth won the Mason's Island Invitational in BONANZA and then George Bates and Family won the Ram Island Invitational also in BONANZA. Ben Carpenter in SARI won the Around Fishers Island Race hosted by Fishers Island Yacht Club while Bob Geary in SAGACIOUS won the end of season Fleet 34 Round The Island Race started by Dr. Bill "bones" Jones in 1970. Paul and Penny Smyth along with his parents Norb and Eileen Smyth hosted the post-race-party.


